

Regular Board Meeting Minutes August 15, 2017 7:30pm

This meeting was called to order by Jim Sipe, Chair at 7:30pm with the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag and using the consent agenda. Doug Wille made a motion to approve the consent agenda. Dan Peine seconded it. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENT

2 deputies present and said all is well here. There was a big crash by the park and ride. Just car accidents and some mail theft. No burglaries. The only question we had was if someone could park overnight at the park and ride. Dan Peine was told they could park there 24/7 but to remove their valuables.

ROAD REPORT

Jason Otte stated we should be getting rock soon. Rock to be spread per the list from Jason, 250th from Hogan to Inga, Inga – 270th to 280th, a portion of 250th, some over by Donnelly, from Donnelly to 47.

Someone on 230th had a concern about bad chloride but Jason Otte said it doesn't seem any different than anywhere else. Dan Peine drove up and down the road a number of times and never saw anything wrong with it. Otte's did a great job on what they trimmed on Fischer.

Doug Wille made a motion to pay Otte Excavating for mowing the ditches. Dan Peine seconded it. Motion carried.

- Leo Nicolai mentioned the Freeburg driveway still needs the culvert so Jason Otte was going to try to contact the utility company again since the utility company dropped the ball last time.

PLANNING COMMISSION SYNOPSIS

• Harold Kimmes - wants to put a non AG (15x50) addition onto his existing shed located at 4450 240th Street East Harold wants to put a 15 foot by 50 foot lean to on from the back of the building. The Planning Commission approved it. Harold stated he needs to get the building drawings to Benny Svien.

Jim Sipe made a motion we approve the building permit for Harold Kimmes for a non AG shed 15x50 subject to approval from our building inspector, Benny Svien. Doug Wille seconded. Motion carried.

Harold was instructed to get with Benny Svien on it. He left one copy with us.

 - o Removal of house (total house fire last month) demo permit
 - o Building permit for new house located at 5120 240th Street East

Joe did not have a full plan but presented a foot plan for the house. The foot plan will not change. Within 2 weeks he will have the real plans. Mark and Janet Otte were in charge of the demo part of it and they left Benny a number of calls but never heard back from him so they did the demo anyway. Joe said the septic has been agreed on what they were doing by Darrel Gilmer. Jim Sipe made a motion that we approve the building permit to build the new house at 5120 240th Street East subject to approval by our building inspector. Doug Wille seconded. Motion carried.

Jonathan Eilen

o Last year requested to put a shed up but didn't have enough acreage. Now he has enough acreage for an AG building. He has 10.10 acres. He wants to put a 50 x 100 pull barn up.

Jonathan was given an application by Molly Weber. He presented it to the Town Board. Dakota County has to say that it is an AG parcel. Jonathan said his tax statement is AG residential. Jonathan said he is going to put his trailers in there for fertilizer, grain trailers, otherwise the winter takes a beating on them. He also wants to put his lawn tractors in there. Jim Sipe is concerned he is not using this for agriculture use. Jonathan stated he hauls for Gerster farm. The question is if it is really used for agriculture. Jim Sipe asked that Jonathan fill out the rest of the AG building permit and to bring all the correct forms that are required, along with what the uses are going to be and the proper attachments. Jim Sipe asked that he bring application and all the forms attached back to the Planning Commission next month.

- 1. Property tax statement identifying the property designation
- 2. List of intended agricultural uses
- Diagram of the building location
 *Owner then needs to initial to attest to the above 3 things and sign it and let the Planning Commission sign it, then bring it back to the Town Board to sign off on it.

Jonathan already asked Benny Svien if he could qualify for an AG building and Benny thought he should qualify as long as he has 10 acres.
