

Annual Meeting Minutes March 14, 2023 8:30pm

- 1. Call the meeting to order This meeting was called to order by clerk, Molly Weber at 8:30pm.
- Pledge Allegiance to the Flag The Pledge of Allegiance to the flag was cited.
- 3. Election of a Moderator Nominations for the Moderator were open. Angie Niebur nominated Jim Sipe. Molly Weber seconded. Motion carried, nominations closed. Jim Sipe was moderator.
- 4. Announce the Agenda for the Rest of the Meeting Jim Sipe read the agenda for the rest of meeting.
- Minutes from last year's Annual Meeting Molly Weber
 Jim Sipe gave the highlights. Jim Sipe made a motion to approve last year Annual Meeting minutes. Angie Niebur seconded. Motion carried.
- 6. The Financial Report Angie Niebur Cemetery CD was moved to savings in November 2022 so we now have: Checking, Savings and Escrow accounts. ARPA (Covid \$) – we received half in 2021 and the other half in 2022. We received \$100,867.50 and \$2,200. Was spent on Town Hall plans so we have \$98,667.50 that can be spent on anything except debt. Now we have a ARPA fund so it made the General fund look deficient.
 Jim Sipe made a motion to approve the financial report. Molly Weber seconded. Motion carried.
- 7. Road Report typical changes here and there. Angie Niebur made a motion to approve the Road Report. Bob Reinardy seconded. Motion carried.
- 8. **Board of Audit Report** completed the financial report. Molly Weber and Angie Niebur's numbers matched. **Jim Sipe made** a motion to accept the Board of Audit Report. Angie Niebur seconded. Motion carried.
- 9. Waiver of reading all checks written and received Jim Sipe made a motion to waive reading all checks written. Bob Reinardy seconded. Motion carried.
- 10. Motions needed to approve levies for the General Fund, Road & Bridge Fund & Fire Fund currently there is over \$300,000. In the checking account so some should go into savings account. We only levied \$30,000. In fire but we paid out \$38,000. Levy doesn't include other money coming in like from permits or tax disbursements. The General Fund also includes the \$7,000. we took from the Cemetery fund and put into the General Fund.

General Fund \$80,000.

Jim Sipe made a motion to approve \$80,000. In the General Fund for the 2023 Levy payable in 2024. Angie Niebur seconded. Motion carried.

Road and Bridge Fund \$170.000.

Jim Sipe made a motion to approve \$170,000. in the Road and Bridge fund for the 2023 Levy payable in 2024. Bob Reinardy seconded. Motion carried.

Fire Fund \$40,000.

Jim Sipe made a motion to approve \$40,000. In the Fire Fund for the 2023 Levy payable in 2024. Bob Reinardy seconded. Motion carried.

TOTAL: \$290,000.

Bob Reinardy agrees numbers are solid and overall bottom line is what matters for 2023 payable in 2024.

- 11. Report of Annual Election 9 casted votes. Jim Sipe was elected as Supervisor for a 3 year term.
- 12. General Discussion of Items of Concern, Residents can voice their opinions on any matter, but such input is only advisory to the Board Bob Reinardy had a question on the New Town Hall. We are very interested in building a New Town Hall but the one we went off of is too big. We intend to redesign it at a more reasonable price. We do not have a price yet. Original one came in at about \$400,000. Would like to do it for half that price. Bob Reinardy suggested to be practical and look at what the actual need for the township is.
- 13. Make a motion on Annual Meeting date and time Molly Weber made a motion for next year's Annual Meeting to be Tuesday March 12, 2024 at 8:30pm. Jim Sipe seconded. Motion carried.
