The planning commission also notes that repairs can be made out of the escrow money that is received from the contractor. It is also noted that the Township could possibly hire the road contractor to do the pre-inspection and post inspection on an on-call basis.

The commission felt that the permit should include the cost to pay for the inspection and administration. They also mentioned that taking pictures can be important if issues arise.

The planning commission also noted that section 103 on page 5 there are conflicting statements. The planning commission suggests discussing this with our lawyer. It is believed that they should remove the combo permit or more clearly explain each permit type.
